## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to equipping each K-9 law enforcement vehicle with a heat 3 alarm system. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 821, Health and Safety 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 821.005 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 821.005. HEAT ALARM SYSTEM IN K-9 LAW ENFORCEMENT 7 VEHICLES. (a) In this section, "law enforcement agency" means: 8 9 (1) the Department of Public Safety; (2) the sheriff's department of a county; or 10 11 (3) the police department of a municipality. 12 (b) A law enforcement agency shall equip each vehicle used 13 in a K-9 law enforcement program with a heat alarm system that is 14 activated when the temperature in the vehicle's interior becomes dangerous to a police dog in the vehicle. The system when activated 15 16 must: (1) activate an audible alarm; and 17 18 (2) automatically start the vehicle and the vehicle's air conditioning system. 19 SECTION 2. A law enforcement agency required to equip a 20 21 vehicle with a heat alarm system as required by Section 821.005, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, is not required to 22 comply with that section before January 1, 2006. 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 24
