1	AN ACT
2	relating to prohibition of certain insurance discrimination.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 544.002, Insurance Code, as effective
5	April 1, 2005, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding
6	Subsection (d) to read as follows:
7	(a) A person may not refuse to insure or provide coverage to
8	an individual, refuse to continue to insure or provide coverage to
9	an individual, limit the amount, extent, or kind of coverage
10	available for an individual, or charge an individual a rate that is
11	different from the rate charged to other individuals for the same
12	coverage because of the individual's:
13	(1) race, color, religion, or national origin;
14	(2) age, gender, marital status, or geographic
15	location; [or]
16	(3) disability or partial disability; or
17	(4) sexual orientation or gender identity or
18	expression.

(d) In this section:

(1) "Gender identity or expression" means a person's

having, or being perceived as having, a gender-related identity,

appearance, expression, or behavior, whether or not that identity,

appearance, expression, or behavior is different from that

stereotypically associated with the person's assigned sex at birth.

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- 1 (2) "Sexual orientation" means actual or perceived
- 2 heterosexuality, homosexuality, or bisexuality.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
