- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 791.011, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 8 (a) A local government may contract or agree with another
  9 local government or a federally recognized Indian tribe, as listed
  10 by the United States secretary of the interior under 25 U.S.C.
  11 Section 479a-1, whose reservation is located within the boundaries
  12 of this state to perform governmental functions and services in
- 13 accordance with this chapter.
- 14 (b-1) A local government that is authorized to enter into an
- 15 <u>interlocal contract under this section may not contract with an</u>
- 16 Indian tribe that is not federally recognized or whose reservation
- is not located within the boundaries of this state.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
