5	SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Penal Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 46.101 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 46.101. DEADLY WEAPON IN SECURED AREA OF AN AIRPORT.
8	(a) A person commits an offense if the person enters a secured area
9	of an airport and the person knowingly carries or conceals a deadly
10	weapon on or about the person's self or in the person's luggage,
11	including any carry-on items.
12	(b) An offense under this section is a felony of the third
13	degree.
14	(c) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this
15	section that at the time of the offense the actor was engaged in
16	conduct authorized by an airport employee having the authority to
17	provide security clearance or by the Transportation Security
18	Administration.
19	(d) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
20	also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the
21	person may be prosecuted under either section or both sections.
22	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
23	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
24	An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is

covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 1 2 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 3 4 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 5 date. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
