5	SECTION 1. Section 192.003, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to
7	read as follows:
8	(d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), a $[A]$ person
9	required to file a birth certificate or report a birth shall file
10	the certificate or make the report not later than the fifth day
11	after the date of the birth.
12	(e) If a parent does not name the child before the fifth day
13	after the date of the birth due to the parent's religious beliefs, a
14	person required to file the birth certificate or report the birth
15	may file the certificate or make the report not later than the fifth
16	day after the date the child is named.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
