A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of a taxing unit to adopt discounts for

3 early payment of ad valorem taxes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 31.05(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as

6 follows:

- 7 (a) The governing body of a taxing unit [that collects its
- 9 Subsection (c) [of this section], or both, in the manner required by
- 10 law for official action by the body. The discounts, if adopted,
- 11 apply to taxes for a taxing unit for which the adopting taxing unit
- 12 collects taxes if the governing body of the other unit, in the
- 13 manner required by law for official action by the body, adopts the
- 14 discounts or approves of their application to its taxes by the
- 15 collecting unit. If a taxing unit adopts both discounts under
- 16 Subsections (b) and (c) [of this section], the discounts adopted
- 17 under Subsection (b) apply unless the [unit mails its] tax bills for
- 18 the unit are mailed after September 30, in which case only the
- 19 discounts under Subsection (c) apply.
- 20 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies to
- the adoption of a discount by a taxing unit beginning with the 2005
- tax year, except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section.
- 23 (b) If a taxing unit's tax bills for the 2005 tax year are
- 24 mailed before the effective date of this Act, the change in law made

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- 1 by this Act applies to the adoption of a discount by the taxing unit
- 2 beginning with the 2006 tax year, and the law in effect when the tax
- 3 bills were mailed applies to the 2005 tax year with respect to that
- 4 taxing unit.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
