1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the designation of United States Highway 80 in this
1-10 state as the World War II Veterans Memorial Highway.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-13 is amended by adding Section 225.0285 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 225.0285. WORLD WAR II VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)
1-15 The part of United States Highway 80 located in this state is
1-16 designated as the World War II Veterans Memorial Highway.

1-17 (b) The department shall design and construct memorial
1-18 markers indicating the highway number, the designation as the World
1-19 War II Veterans Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate
1-20 information.

1-21 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the department
1-22 shall erect a marker at each end of the highway and at each county
1-23 line crossed by the highway.

1-24 (d) The department is not required to design, construct, or
1-25 erect a marker under this section unless a grant or donation of
1-26 private funds is made to the department to cover the cost of the
1-27 design, construction, and erection of the marker.

1-28 (e) Money received under Subsection (d) shall be deposited
1-29 to the credit of the state highway fund.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
