- 11 makes political expenditures, except that:
- 12 (1) a county executive committee that accepts
- 13 political contributions or makes political expenditures shall
- 14 maintain the records required by Section 254.001; and
- 15 (2) a county executive committee that accepts
- 16 political contributions or makes political expenditures that, in
- 17 the aggregate, exceed $\frac{$25,000}{$}$ [$\frac{$5,000}{$}$] in a calendar year shall
- 18 file:
- 19 (A) a campaign treasurer appointment as required
- 20 by Section 252.001 not later than the 15th day after the date that
- 21 amount is exceeded; and
- 22 (B) the reports required by Subchapter F, Chapter
- 23 254, including in the political committee's first report all
- 24 political contributions accepted and all political expenditures

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
