A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to prohibiting the sale of fireworks by or to a person
- 3 under 18 years of age and to the prosecution of offenses involving
- 4 fireworks.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2154.251, Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) A person may not in the course of the person's business
- 9 employ or allow a person under 18 years of age to manufacture,
- 10 distribute, sell, or use fireworks.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 2154.252(c), Occupations Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (c) A person [Fireworks] may not sell or offer to sell
- 14 fireworks [be sold or offered for sale] to a person [children] under
- 15 18 $[\frac{12}{2}]$ years of age or to an intoxicated or incompetent person. A
- 16 person selling fireworks at retail shall make a reasonable effort
- 17 to determine that potential purchasers of fireworks are of the
- 18 minimum age required by this subsection.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 2154.303(c), Occupations Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (c) A violation of Section 2154.251(a)(1), (2), (3), (4), or
- 22 (5) that results in property damage in an amount of less than \$200
- 23 and does not result in bodily injury or death is a Class C
- 24 misdemeanor. A violation of Section 2154.252(c) is a Class C

1 <u>misdemeanor</u>.

- 2 SECTION 4. (a) The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 3 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 4 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 5 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 6 before that date.
- 7 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 8 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 9 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect June 20, 2005, if it
- 11 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 12 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 13 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 14 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
