- 9 <u>emergency services personnel retirement fund:</u>
- 10 (1) 30 percent of the amount of the annual tax
- 11 collected under this chapter for calendar year 2006 and
- 12 attributable to gross premiums for fire insurance and allied lines;
- 13 <u>and</u>
- 14 (2) 29.1 percent of the amount of the annual tax
- 15 collected under this chapter for calendar year 2007 and
- 16 attributable to gross premiums for fire insurance and allied lines.
- 17 (b) This section expires December 31, 2008.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
