- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.856(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) For a state fiscal biennium, the amount appropriated
- 9 from the undedicated portion of the general revenue fund under
- 10 Subsection (a) may not be less than the sum of:
- 11 (1) the amount of money deposited to the credit of the
- account during that biennium under Section 51.855; [and]
- 13 (2) the market value of any in-kind contributions
- 14 accepted by the consortium during that biennium under Section
- 15 51.855, as determined by the comptroller based on information
- 16 provided to the comptroller by the consortium and verified by the
- 17 coordinating board; and
- 18 (3) the amount or value, as appropriate, of any gift,
- 19 grant, or donation that the coordinating board determines was:
- 20 <u>(A) applied for and received by an eligible</u>
- 21 computer science institution, eligible engineering institution, or
- 22 eligible private or independent engineering institution during
- that biennium for the purposes for which grants are awarded under
- 24 Section 51.857(a); and

- 1 (B) received from a source other than a
- 2 participant in the consortium.
- 3 SECTION 2. Sections 51.860(a) and (c), Education Code, are
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) To evaluate the effectiveness of the grant program under
- 6 this subchapter, the coordinating board shall appoint an <u>evaluation</u>
- 7 [advisory] committee consisting of:
 - (1) higher education representatives; and
- 9 (2) experts in the fields of engineering and computer
- 10 science.

- 11 (c) The grant program evaluation committee is not subject to
- 12 Chapter 2110, Government Code.
- SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 14 51.856(b), Education Code, applies only to an appropriation made
- for a period that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 (b) On the effective date of this Act, the members of the
- 17 advisory committee established by Section 51.860, Education Code,
- 18 serving on that date become members of the evaluation committee
- 19 established by Section 51.860, Education Code, as amended by this
- 20 Act.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
