4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 62, Parks and Wildlife
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 62.002 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 62.002. HUNTING OF SEVERELY WOUNDED OR DANGEROUS
7	WILDLIFE. (a) In this section, "wildlife" means a wild mammal,
8	bird, fish, reptile, or amphibian.
9	(b) A person may hunt by any method wildlife that:
10	(1) leaves a blood trail or is unable to move but would
11	leave a blood trail if the wildlife were able to move; or
12	(2) behaves in a manner that:
13	(A) is inconsistent with the manner in which
14	wildlife that is not diseased typically behaves; and
15	(B) leads a reasonable person to believe that the
16	wildlife poses a substantial risk of serious harm to a person or
17	another wildlife resource.
18	(c) Not later than the second day after the date on which a
19	person hunts wildlife under this section, the person shall report
20	the hunting to the department in the manner prescribed by the
21	commission.
22	(d) The department may not require a person to possess a
23	license or permit to hunt wildlife under this section.
