A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the release of a solid waste in connection with dredging
- 3 and placement or storage of dredged material by a political
- 4 subdivision.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 361.025, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(c) Activities of a political subdivision created under</u>
- 9 Section 59, Article XVI, or Section 52, Article III, Texas
- 10 Constitution, performed in connection with the construction and
- 11 maintenance of waterways to facilitate navigation in waters in the
- 12 jurisdiction of the political subdivision are exempt from
- 13 regulation under this chapter. Exempt activities include
- 14 activities associated with dredging materials from navigable
- 15 waters in the jurisdiction of the political subdivision and the
- 16 placement of those materials.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 361.271, Health and Safety Code, is
- amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 19 (g) A political subdivision created under Section 59,
- 20 Article XVI, or Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, is not
- 21 a person responsible under this chapter for solid waste released or
- threatened to be released in connection with:
- 23 (1) the dredging of materials from navigable waters or
- the banks of navigable waters in the jurisdiction of the political

- 1 <u>subdivision;</u>
- 2 (2) the placement or storage of dredged materials on
- 3 land or submerged land; or
- 4 (3) the construction, operation, or maintenance of a
- 5 placement area for dredged material.
- 6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act does not apply
- 7 to an act or governmental proceeding of a political subdivision
- 8 created under Section 59, Article XVI, or Section 52, Article III,
- 9 Texas Constitution, that is the subject of litigation pending on
- 10 the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
