5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is

6 amended by adding Section 55.17526 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 55.17526. THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SYSTEM; ADDITIONAL

BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this

subchapter, the board of regents of The University of Texas System

may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, enlarge, or

equip property, buildings, structures, or other facilities,

including roads and related infrastructure, to complete Phase V

construction at The University of Texas at San Antonio downtown

campus, to be financed by the issuance of bonds in accordance with

15 this subchapter, including bonds issued in accordance with a

systemwide revenue financing program and secured as provided by

that program, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$17

19 (b) The board of regents may pledge irrevocably to the

20 payment of the bonds authorized by this section all or any part of

the revenue funds of an institution, branch, or entity of The

University of Texas System, including student tuition charges. The

23 amount of a pledge made under this subsection may not be reduced or

24 abrogated while the bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds

- 1 <u>issued to refund those bonds</u>, are outstanding.
- 2 (c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board of
- 3 regents to meet its obligations under this section, the board may
- 4 transfer funds among institutions, branches, and entities of The
- 5 University of Texas System to ensure the most equitable and
- 6 efficient allocation of available resources for each institution,
- 7 branch, or entity to carry out its duties and purposes.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
