- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 130.0103 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 130.0103. DUAL USAGE EDUCATIONAL COMPLEX. (a) With
- 9 the approval of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, the
- 10 board of trustees of a junior college district may establish and
- 11 operate a dual usage educational complex to provide a shared
- 12 <u>facility</u> for the educational activities of the district and other
- 13 participating entities. The board of trustees may enter into a
- 14 cooperative agreement governing the operation and use of the
- 15 complex with the governing bodies of one or more of the following
- 16 entities:

- 17 (1) a county, municipality, or school district located
- 18 <u>in whole or in part in the service area of the junior college</u>
- 19 district; or
- 20 (2) another institution of higher education with a
- 21 campus or other educational facility located in the same state
- 22 uniform service region as adopted by the coordinating board.
- 23 (b) The junior college district shall coordinate and
- 24 supervise the operation of the complex. The use and the costs

- 1 associated with the establishment and operation of the complex
- 2 shall be shared by the district and the other participating
- 3 <u>entities under the terms of the cooperative agreement.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
