- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 345.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 345.002. EVIDENCE OF INTENT TO SELL. The possession
- 8 of bedding by a manufacturer, renovator, wholesaler, or person
- 9 holding an inspection and cleaning [a germicidal treatment] permit
- 10 in the course of business is presumptive evidence of an intent to
- 11 sell the bedding.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 345.024, Health and Safety Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 345.024. INSPECTION AND CLEANING [GERMICIDAL
- 15 TREATMENT] OF BEDDING AND MATERIALS. (a) Except as provided by
- 16 Subsection (b), a person may not sell secondhand bedding or bedding
- 17 manufactured in whole or in part from secondhand or recycled
- 18 material unless the bedding has been <u>inspected</u> [germicidally
- 19 treated] and cleaned by a method approved by the department.
- 20 (b) An upholstered sofa bed, reclining chair, or studio
- 21 couch shall be <u>inspected</u> [germicidally treated] and cleaned only
- 22 when required by department rules.
- (c) A person may not use in the manufacture, repair, or
- 24 renovation of bedding a material that has not been inspected and

- 1 cleaned [and germicidally treated] by a process or treatment
- 2 approved by the department if the material:
- 3 (1) has been used by a person with a communicable
- 4 disease; or
- 5 (2) is filthy, oily, stained, or harbors loathsome
- 6 insects or pathogenic organisms.
- 7 (d) A person may not sell material or bedding requiring
- 8 inspection and cleaning [germicidal treatment] under this section
- 9 unless the person inspecting and cleaning the material or bedding
- 10 [applying the germicidal treatment] securely attaches by a method
- 11 approved by the department a label that is at least 12 square inches
- 12 and contains, plainly printed in ink:
- 13 (1) a statement that the article or material has been
- inspected and cleaned [germicidally treated] by a method approved
- 15 by the department;
- 16 (2) a statement of the method of <u>inspection and</u>
- 17 cleaning [germicidal treatment applied];
- 18 (3) the date the article was <u>inspected and cleaned</u>
- 19 [germicidally treated];
- 20 (4) the name and address of the person for whom the
- 21 article was <u>inspected and cleaned</u> [germicidally treated]; and
- 22 (5) the permit number of the person performing
- 23 [applying] the inspection and cleaning [germicidal treatment].
- SECTION 3. The heading to Section 345.042, Health and
- 25 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 345.042. PERMIT TO INSPECT AND CLEAN [APPLY GERMICIDAL
- 27 TREATMENT].

- 1 SECTION 4. Section 345.042, Health and Safety Code, is
- 2 amended by amending Subsections (a), (c), and (d) to read as
- 3 follows:

- 4 (a) A person may not <u>inspect and clean bedding</u> [apply a germicidal process] unless:
- 6 (1) the <u>inspection and cleaning method</u> [process] has
  7 been registered with and approved by the department; and
- 8 (2) the person has a numbered <u>inspection and cleaning</u>
  9 [<del>germicidal treatment</del>] permit issued by the department.
- 10 (c) A person who holds a permit shall keep the permit
  11 conspicuously posted on the premises of the person's business [near
- (d) A person who holds a permit shall keep an accurate record of all materials that have been <u>inspected and cleaned</u>
  [germicidally treated]. The record must include the:
- 16 (1) source of the material;

- 17 (2) date of inspection and cleaning [treatment]; and
- 18 (3) name and address of the owner of each item.
- 19 SECTION 5. The heading to Section 345.083, Health and 20 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 345.083. <u>DEPARTMENT INSPECTION OF FACILITIES</u>.
- SECTION 6. Section 345.083(a), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) To determine compliance with this chapter or a rule 25 adopted under this chapter, a representative of the department may 26 enter a place at which:
- 27 (1) bedding is manufactured, repaired, renovated,

- 1 <u>cleaned,</u> stored, or sold;
- 2 (2) materials are prepared for use in bedding; or
- 3 (3) <u>inspection</u> [<del>germicidal treatment</del>] of bedding is
- 4 performed.
- 5 SECTION 7. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 6 345.024, Health and Safety Code, applies only to bedding,
- 7 materials, or upholstered items sold on or after January 1, 2006.
- 8 Bedding, materials, or upholstered items that are sold before
- 9 January 1, 2006, are governed by the law in effect on the date of the
- 10 sale, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 8. (a) A person who, on the effective date of this
- 12 Act, is operating under a germicidal treatment permit issued under
- 13 Chapter 345, Health and Safety Code, is entitled to an inspection
- 14 and cleaning permit under that chapter, as amended by this Act, if
- the person demonstrates on or before January 1, 2006, in the manner
- 16 required by the Department of State Health Services, that the
- 17 person satisfies the requirements for issuance of the inspection
- 18 and cleaning permit.
- 19 (b) The Department of State Health Services shall issue an
- 20 inspection and cleaning permit under Subsection (a) of this section
- 21 without requiring payment of the fee for issuance of an initial
- 22 permit.
- (c) An inspection and cleaning permit issued to a person
- 24 under Subsection (a) of this section expires on the expiration date
- of the person's germicidal treatment permit.
- 26 (d) A person described by Subsection (a) of this section who
- 27 does not demonstrate that the person satisfies the requirements for

- 1 issuance of the inspection and cleaning permit before January 2,
- 2 2006, must apply for a new inspection and cleaning permit under
- 3 Chapter 345, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, and pay
- 4 the fee for the issuance of a new permit.
- 5 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
