A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to supplemental pay for members of the Texas National
- 3 Guard who suffer economic hardship when called to active military

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 431.0821, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (a) and (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 (a) A person who is called to active military duty as a
- 10 member of the Texas National Guard in the service of this state or
- 11 the United States by proper federal or state authority and who
- 12 suffers an economic hardship <u>caused by an income reducti</u>on of 25
- 13 <u>percent or more</u> as a result of serving on active duty is eligible to
- 14 receive supplemental pay for serving on active duty in accordance
- 15 with this section.
- 16 (e) The adjutant general shall [may] adopt rules to
- 17 implement this section, including rules that prescribe the
- 18 procedure for requesting supplemental pay and that prescribe
- 19 evidence a member may or must present to demonstrate hardship. The
- 20 comptroller, in consultation with the adjutant general, <u>shall</u> [may]
- 21 adopt rules to govern the manner and method of paying supplemental
- 22 pay under this section.
- 23 (f) The adjutant general is the final arbiter of any dispute
- 24 arising from this section. A member may not appeal a decision of

- 1 the adjutant general under this section to a court.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
