## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the purchasing and contracting authority of 3 commissaries operated by sheriffs.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 351.0415, Local Government Code, 5 is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 6
- (e) In reviewing bids under Subsection (b)(3), the sheriff 7 shall consider whether the contract should provide for a fixed rate 8 9 of return by which a supplier pays a set amount to the sheriff on a daily, monthly, or annual basis. 10
- SECTION 2. Section 351.04155, Local Government Code, 11 12 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 13
- 14 (a) This section applies only to a county that:
- has a population of one million or more; and 15
- 16 (2) has two municipalities with a population of  $200,000 \left[ \frac{300,000}{1} \right]$  or more. 17
- 18 (c) A purchase made by the sheriff using commissary proceeds is subject to the competitive purchasing procedures contained in 19 Subchapter C, Chapter 262. For the purpose of complying with that 20 21 subchapter, a reference in that subchapter to "commissioners court" 22 means the sheriff and a reference to "the county official who makes purchases for the county" means the sheriff or the sheriff's 23 designee. 24
