4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 361.0667 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 361.0667. ADDITIONAL NOTICE CONCERNING PERMIT
8	APPLICATION FOR MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE FACILITY. (a) The
9	commission shall require an applicant for a permit, permit
10	amendment, or, to the extent required under Subsection (c), a
11	modification to a permit for a municipal solid waste facility to
12	mail notice of intent to obtain, amend, or modify a permit by a date
13	determined by commission rule to:
14	(1) each residential or business address located
15	within one mile of the facility; and
16	(2) each owner of real property located within one
17	mile of the facility listed in the real property appraisal records
18	of the appraisal district in which the facility is permitted or
19	sought to be permitted.
20	(b) The applicant must certify to the commission the
21	applicant's compliance with Subsection (a). Acceptance of
22	certification creates a rebuttable presumption that the applicant
23	has complied with this section. Substantial compliance with the
24	notice requirements of Subsection (a) is sufficient for the

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commission to exercise jurisdiction over the application. 1 2 (c) An applicant for a modification to a permit for a municipal solid waste facility is required to comply with this 3 4 section only if the modification is of a type that requires notification as determined by commission rule. 5 6 SECTION 2. Section 361.0667, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an application for a permit, 7 amendment to a permit, or modification to a permit for a municipal 8 solid waste facility filed with the commission on or after the 9 effective date of this Act. An application filed with the 10 commission before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 11 law in effect at the time the application is filed, and the current 12 law is continued in effect for that purpose. 13 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
