- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.054(b), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A person subject to this section shall notify the
- 8 department of the change not later than the 30th day after the date
- 9 on which the change takes effect and[, except as provided by
- 10 Subsection (d), shall apply for a duplicate license or certificate
- 11 as provided by Section 521.146.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 521.424, Transportation Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 521.424. DUPLICATE LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE FEE. [<del>(a)</del>]
- 15 The fee for a duplicate driver's license or duplicate personal
- 16 identification certificate is \$10.
- 17 [(b) The fee for a duplicate disability certificate or
- 18 duplicate health condition certificate is \$5.
- 19 SECTION 3. The following provisions of the Transportation
- 20 Code are repealed:
- 21 (1) Sections 521.054(d), (e), and (f);
- 22 (2) Section 521.102; and
- 23 (3) Section 521.423.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
