1-9 relating to certain obsolete documents issued in connection with

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 521.054(b), Transportation Code, is
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 (b) A person subject to this section shall notify the
1-15 department of the change not later than the 30th day after the date
1-16 on which the change takes effect and~~[, except as provided by~~
1-17 ~~Subsection (d), shall]~~ apply for a duplicate license or certificate
1-18 as provided by Section 521.146.

1-19 SECTION 2. Section 521.424, Transportation Code, is amended
1-20 to read as follows:

1-21 Sec. 521.424. DUPLICATE LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE FEE. ~~[(a)]~~
1-22 The fee for a duplicate driver's license or duplicate personal
1-23 identification certificate is \$10.

1-24 ~~[(b) The fee for a duplicate disability certificate or~~
1-25 ~~duplicate health condition certificate is \$5.]~~

1-26 SECTION 3. The following provisions of the Transportation
1-27 Code are repealed:

1-28 (1) Sections 521.054(d), (e), and (f);

1-29 (2) Section 521.102; and

1-30 (3) Section 521.423.

1-31 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
