## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the jurisdiction of a court with respect to an action
- 3 involving a testamentary trust.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5, Texas Probate Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (e-1) In those counties in which there is a statutory probate
- 8 court, all actions involving a testamentary trust shall be filed
- 9 and heard in the statutory probate court regardless of whether the
- 10 matter is appertaining or incident to an estate. In those counties
- 11 <u>in which there is no statutory probate court</u>, the district court has
- 12 exclusive jurisdiction over all actions involving a testamentary
- 13 <u>trust.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 5(e-1), Texas Probate Code, as added by
- 15 this Act, applies only to an action that is filed on or after the
- 16 effective date of this Act. An action that is filed before the
- 17 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- date the action was filed, and the former law is continued in effect
- 19 for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
