- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 42.091, Penal Code, is

- 6 Sec. 42.091. ASSAULT [ATTACK] ON ASSISTANCE ANIMAL.
- SECTION 2. Sections 42.091(a)-(c), Penal Code, are amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (a) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally,
- 10 knowingly, or recklessly [ $\frac{\text{attacks}_{\tau}}{\text{ot}}$ ] injures[ $\frac{\tau}{\tau}$ ] or kills an
- 11 assistance animal belonging to another without legal authority or
- 12 the owner's consent.
- 13 (b) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally,
- 14 knowingly, or recklessly incites or permits an animal owned by or
- otherwise in the custody of the actor to  $[attack_{\tau}]$  injure  $[\tau]$  or kill
- 16 an assistance animal [and, as a result of the person's conduct, the
- 17 assistance animal is attacked, injured, or killed].
- 18 (c) An offense under this section is a:
- 19 (1) [Class A misdemeanor if the actor or an animal

- 1 (2) [(3)] felony of the third degree if the actor or an animal owned by or otherwise in the custody of the actor kills an assistance animal.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 7 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 8 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 9 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 10 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 11 date.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
