4	SECTION 1. Section 1001.204(a), Occupations Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:

- 14 may renew an unexpired license by paying the required annual
- 15 renewal fee to the board before the expiration date of the license.
- 16 A person whose license has expired may not engage in activities that
- 17 require a license until the license has been renewed.
- 18 (b) A person whose license has been expired for 90 days or
- 19 less may renew the license by paying to the board the required
- 20 <u>annual</u> [a] renewal fee, a late [that is equal to 1-1/2 times the
- 21 normally required] renewal fee, and any applicable increase in fees
- as required by Section 1001.206.
- (c) A person whose license has been expired for more than 90
- 24 days but less than two years may renew the license by paying to the
- 25 board the required annual [a] renewal fee, a late [that is equal to
- 26 two times the normally required] renewal fee, and any applicable
- 27 increase in fees as required by Section 1001.206 for each

- 2 SECTION 4. Section 1001.401(b), Occupations Code, is

- 4 (b) A plan, specification, plat, or report issued by a

- 7 license holder is not required to use a seal required by this
- 8 section if the project is to be constructed or used in another state

- 10 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act relating to
- 11 the renewal of a license under Chapter 1001, Occupations Code,
- 12 apply only to a license that expires on or after the effective date
- 13 of this Act. A license that expires before the effective date of
- 14 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the license
- 15 expired, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
