5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 51.9461 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 51.9461. CHARGES AND FEES FOR CERTAIN PAYMENTS AT
9	PRIVATE OR INDEPENDENT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. (a) In
10	this section, "private or independent institution of higher
11	education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
12	(b) This section applies only to a payment of tuition, a
13	fee, or another charge made by or on behalf of a student, including
14	a person admitted but not yet enrolled, of a private or independent
15	institution of higher education if the payment is made or
16	authorized in person, by mail, by telephone call, or through the
17	Internet by means of:
18	(1) an electronic funds transfer; or
19	(2) a credit card.
20	(c) A private or independent institution of higher
21	education may charge a fee or other amount in connection with a
22	payment to which this section applies, in addition to the amount of
23	the tuition, fee, or other charge being paid, including:
24	(1) a discount, convenience, or service charge for the

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1 transaction; or

2 (2) a service charge in connection with a payment 3 transaction that is dishonored or refused for lack of funds or 4 insufficient funds.

5 (d) A fee or other charge under this section must be in an 6 amount reasonable and necessary to reimburse the institution for 7 the expense incurred by the institution in processing and handling 8 the payment or payment transaction.

9 <u>(e) Before accepting a payment by credit card, the</u> 10 <u>institution shall notify the student or other person making the</u> 11 <u>payment of any fee to be charged under this section.</u>

SECTION 2. Section 54.5011(c), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

(c) A fee or other charge under this section must be in an
amount <u>reasonable and necessary to reimburse the institution for</u>
[reasonably related to] the expense incurred by the institution in
processing and handling the payment or payment transaction.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
