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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to certain requirements imposed on a sex offender who 3 enters the premises of a public park. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Article 62.03(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, is 6 amended to read as follows: 7 (a) Before a person who will be subject to registration under this chapter is due to be released from a penal institution, 8 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or the Texas Youth 9 Commission shall determine the person's level of risk to the 10 11 community using the sex offender screening tool developed or 12 selected under Article 62.035 and assign to the person a numeric risk level of one, two, or three. Before releasing the person, an 13 14 official of the penal institution shall: 15 (1)inform the person that: not later than the seventh day after the date 16 (A) on which the person is released or the date on which the person 17 18 moves from a previous residence to a new residence in this state, 19 the person must: register or verify registration with (i) 20 21 the local law enforcement authority in the municipality or county in which the person intends to reside; or 22 23 (ii) if the person has not moved to an 24 intended residence, report to the juvenile probation officer,

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1 community supervision and corrections department officer, or
2 parole officer supervising the person;

3 (B) not later than the seventh day before the date on which the person moves to a new residence in this state or 4 5 another state, the person must report in person to the local law enforcement authority designated as the person's 6 primary 7 registration authority by the department and to the juvenile 8 probation officer, community supervision and corrections department officer, or parole officer supervising the person; 9

(C) not later than the 10th day after the date on 10 which the person arrives in another state in which the person 11 12 intends to reside, the person must register with the law enforcement agency that is identified by the department as the 13 14 agency designated by that state to receive registration 15 information, if the other state has a registration requirement for sex offenders; 16

17 (D) not later than the 30th day after the date on which the person is released, the person must apply to the 18 department in person for the issuance of an original or renewal 19 driver's license or personal identification certificate and a 20 21 failure to apply to the department as required by this paragraph results in the automatic revocation of any driver's license or 22 personal identification certificate issued by the department to the 23 24 person; [and]

(E) the person must notify appropriate entities
 of any change in status as described by Article 62.05; <u>and</u>

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park as described by Article 62.0452, the person must immediately notify a law enforcement agency with jurisdiction over the public park of the person's presence and the person's registration status under this chapter; (2) the statement, certify that the person was so informed; including a photograph and complete set of fingerprints; and complete the registration form for the person. (4) SECTION 2. Chapter 62, Code of Criminal Procedure, amended by adding Article 62.0452 to read as follows: (b) A person subject to registration under this chapter who enters the premises of any public park in this state shall of the public park. 2 SECTION 3. Article 62.06, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 3 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

4 (f) A local law enforcement authority who provides a person
5 with a registration form for verification as required by this
6 chapter shall include with the form a statement and description of
7 the person's registration duties under Article 62.0452.

8 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 9 person subject to registration under Chapter 62, Code of Criminal 10 Procedure, for an offense or conduct that was committed before, on, 11 or after the effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
