5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 531.082 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 531.082. TRANSFER OF MONEY FOR COMMUNITY-BASED
9	SERVICES. (a) The commission shall quantify the amount of money
10	appropriated by the legislature that would have been spent during
11	the remainder of a state fiscal biennium to care for a person who
12	lives in a nursing facility but who is leaving that facility before
13	the end of the biennium to live in the community with the assistance
14	of community-based services.
15	(b) Notwithstanding any other state law and to the maximum
16	extent allowed by federal law, the executive commissioner shall
17	direct, as appropriate:
18	(1) the comptroller, at the time the person described
19	by Subsection (a) leaves the nursing facility, to transfer an
20	amount not to exceed the amount quantified under that subsection
21	among the health and human services agencies and the commission as
22	necessary to comply with this section; or
23	(2) the commission or a health and human services
24	agency, at the time the person described by Subsection (a) leaves

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1	the nursing facility, to transfer an amount not to exceed the amount
2	quantified under that subsection within the agency's budget as
3	necessary to comply with this section.
4	(c) The commission shall ensure that the amount transferred
5	under this section is redirected by the commission or health and
6	human services agency, as applicable, to one or more
7	community-based programs in the amount necessary to provide
8	community-based services to the person after the person leaves the
9	nursing facility.
10	SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
11	a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
12	federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

13 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 14 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 15 waiver or authorization is granted.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
