11	shall specify the size and graphic design of the sign. The sign
12	must contain the following wording:
13	ATTENTION WOMEN CONSIDERING BECOMING PREGNANT, PREGNANT
14	WOMEN, NURSING MOTHERS, AND PARENTS OF YOUNG CHILDREN
15	Some fish and shellfish, especially large fish such as shark,
16	swordfish, king mackerel, and tilefish, contain high levels of
17	mercury that may harm the developing nervous system of a child.
