1 (3) [(4)] is adjudged guilty of an offense for which 2 punishment is increased under Section 481.134(c), (d), (e), or (f), 3 Health and Safety Code, if it is shown that the defendant has been 4 previously convicted of an offense for which punishment was 5 increased under any one of those subsections.

6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 7 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 8 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 9 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 10 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 11 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was 12 committed before that date. 13
