2 relating to the application of laws awarding credit to an inmate for
3 time between release on and subsequent revocation of parole,
4 mandatory supervision, or conditional pardon.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 11, Chapter 856, Acts of
7 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, the change in law made
8 by Section 7 of that Act to Section 508.283, Government Code,
9 applies to the calculation of the remaining sentence for an inmate
10 whose release on parole, mandatory supervision, or conditional
11 pardon is revoked regardless of whether the revocation occurred
12 before, on, or after September 1, 2001.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2006.
