1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the application of laws awarding credit to an inmate for
- 3 time between release on and subsequent revocation of parole,
- 4 mandatory supervision, or conditional pardon.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 11, Chapter 856, Acts of
- 7 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, the change in law made
- 8 by Section 7 of that Act to Section 508.283, Government Code,
- 9 applies to the calculation of the remaining sentence for an inmate
- 10 whose release on parole, mandatory supervision, or conditional
- 11 pardon is revoked regardless of whether the revocation occurred
- 12 before, on, or after September 1, 2001.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
