- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 117, Human Resources Code, 6 is amended by adding Section 117.074 to read as follows:
- Sec. 117.074. RATES FOR MEDICAL SERVICES. (a) The executive

 commissioner by rule shall adopt standards governing the

 determination of rates paid for medical services provided under
- this chapter. The rules must provide for an annual reevaluation of
- 11 the rates.

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- 12 <u>(b) The executive commissioner shall establish a schedule</u>
- of rates based on the standards adopted under Subsection (a). In
- 14 adopting the rate schedule, the executive commissioner shall:
- 15 (1) compare the proposed rate schedule to other
- 16 cost-based and resource-based rates for medical services,
- 17 including rates paid under the medical assistance program under
- 18 Chapter 32 and the Medicare program; and
- 19 (2) for any rate adopted that exceeds the lower of the
- 20 <u>medical assistance or Medicare rate for the same or a similar</u>
- 21 service, document the reasons why the adopted rate reflects
- 22 <u>consideration</u> of the best value, provider availability, and
- 23 consumer choice.
- 24 (c) The executive commissioner shall provide notice to

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- 1 <u>interested persons and allow those persons to present comments</u>
- 2 before adopting the standards and schedule of rates under
- 3 <u>Subsections (a) and (b).</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. Sections 91.029, 111.0551, and 111.0552, Human
- 5 Resources Code, are repealed.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
