8	chapter applies only to a municipality:
9	(1) that:
10	(A) has a population of 10,000 or more;
11	(B) has a paid fire department <u>or</u> [and] police
12	department; and
13	(C) has voted to adopt this chapter or the law
14	codified by this chapter; or
15	(2) whose election to adopt this chapter and whose
16	acts subsequent to that election were validated by the law enacted
17	by House Bill 822, Acts of the 73rd Legislature, Regular Session,
18	1993.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
