5	SECTION 1. Section 162.001(c), Occupations Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(c) The board shall certify a health organization to
8	contract with or employ physicians licensed by the board if the
9	organization:
10	(1) is <u>:</u>
11	(A) a nonprofit corporation under the Texas
12	Non-Profit Corporation Act (Article 1396-1.01 et seq., Vernon's
13	Texas Civil Statutes) and Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code
14	of 1986 (26 U.S.C. Sec. 501(c)(3)); <u>or</u>
15	(B) a hospital district:
16	(i) recognized by a federal agency as a
17	public entity for the purposes of receiving a grant related to a
18	community or federally qualified health center described by
19	Subdivision (2); and
20	(ii) located in a county that borders the
21	United Mexican States; and
22	(2) is organized and operated as:
23	(A) a migrant, community, or homeless health
24	center under the authority of and in compliance with 42 U.S.C.

Section 254b or 254c; or
(B) a federally qualified health center under 42
U.S.C. Section 1396d(1)(2)(B).
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
