- 9 employee" means a peace officer, fire fighter, detention officer,
- 10 county jailer, or emergency medical services employee of this [the]
- 11 state or a political subdivision of this [the] state.
- 12 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 13 607.001, Government Code, apply only to an exposure to a contagious
- 14 disease that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 15 exposure that occurs before the effective date of this Act is
- 16 governed by the law in effect at the time the exposure occurred, and
- 17 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
