- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. (a) In this section:
- 5 (1) "Master electrician" means an individual who,
- 6 while under the supervision required by this section:
- 7 (A) held a municipal or regional license as a
- 8 master electrician; or
- 9 (B) was employed in a position with overall
- 10 responsibility for electrical work that met industry standards.
- 11 (2) "Master sign electrician" means an individual who,
- 12 while under the supervision required by this section:
- 13 (A) held a municipal or regional license as a
- 14 master sign electrician; or
- 15 (B) was employed in a position with overall
- 16 responsibility for electrical work that met industry standards.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding Section 3, Chapter 1062, Acts of the
- 18 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, the Texas Department of
- 19 Licensing and Regulation shall issue a license to a qualified
- 20 applicant under this section who:
- 21 (1) applies for a license under this section not later
- 22 than December 31, 2005;
- 23 (2) submits to the department the information required
- 24 by rule;

- 1 (3) held a municipal or regional license for at least
- one year before June 1, 2004;
- 3 (4) completed the experience required by this section
- 4 before June 1, 2004; and
- 5 (5) pays the application fee.
- 6 (c) An applicant for a license under this section as a
- 7 master electrician is required to have:
- 8 (1) completed at least 12,000 hours of on-the-job
- 9 training under the supervision of a master electrician; and
- 10 (2) held a municipal or regional master electrician
- 11 license.
- 12 (d) An applicant for a license under this section as a
- 13 master sign electrician is required to have:
- 14 (1) completed at least 12,000 hours of on-the-job
- 15 training under the supervision of a master sign electrician; and
- 16 (2) held a municipal or regional master sign
- 17 electrician license.
- 18 (e) An applicant for a license under this section as a
- 19 journeyman electrician is required to have:
- 20 (1) completed at least 12,000 hours of on-the-job
- 21 training under the supervision of a master electrician; or
- 22 (2) held a municipal or regional journeyman
- 23 electrician license.
- 24 (f) An applicant for a license under this section as a
- journeyman sign electrician is required to have:
- 26 (1) completed at least 12,000 hours of on-the-job
- 27 training under the supervision of a master sign electrician; or

- 1 (2) held a municipal or regional journeyman sign
- 2 electrician license.
- 3 (g) An applicant for a license under this section as a
- 4 residential wireman is required to have:
- 5 (1) completed at least 8,000 hours of on-the-job
- 6 training under the supervision of a master electrician; or
- 7 (2) held a municipal or regional residential wireman
- 8 license for at least one year.
- 9 (h) An applicant for a license under this section as a
- 10 maintenance electrician is required to have:
- 11 (1) completed at least 12,000 hours of on-the-job
- 12 training under the supervision of a master electrician; or
- 13 (2) held a municipal or regional maintenance
- 14 electrician license.
- 15 (i) This section expires September 1, 2006.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
