12	(1) accept a credit card for the payment of any fees
13	and charges imposed by the district;
14	(2) collect a fee, not to exceed five percent of the

18	(3) collect a service charge for the expense incurred

20	payment by credit card is not honored by the credit card company on

1	(d) The district may not collect the service charge under
2	Subsection (b)(3) if:
3	(1) the district is notified at the time of payment
4	that the payment is not honored; and
5	(2) the customer immediately submits to the district
