- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1361.002, Insurance Code, as effective
- 6 April 1, 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1361.002. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. (a) This chapter
- 8 applies only to a group health benefit plan delivered, issued for
- 9 delivery, or renewed in this state that provides coverage for
- 10 medical or surgical expenses incurred as a result of accident or
- 11 sickness, including:
- 12 (1) a group insurance policy;
- 13 (2) a group contract issued by a group hospital
- 14 service corporation operating under Chapter 842; and
- 15 (3) a group contract issued by a health maintenance
- organization operating under Chapter 843.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a group standard health
- benefit plan provided under Chapter 1507 or Article 3.80 or 20A.09N
- 19 <u>must provide the coverage required by this chapter.</u>
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- renewed on or after January 1, 2006. A health benefit plan that is
- delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2006,
- is covered by the law in effect at the time the health benefit plan

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- 1 was delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed, and that law is
- 2 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
