- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 254.036(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), (e), or (f), each
- 9 report filed under this chapter with the commission must be filed
- 10 by<u>:</u>
- 11 (1) computer diskette, modem, or other means of
- 12 electronic transfer, using computer software provided by the
- 13 commission or computer software that meets commission
- 14 specifications for a standard file format; or
- 15 (2) telephonic facsimile machine.
- SECTION 2. Section 254.036(b), Election Code, as amended by
- this Act, applies only to a report under Chapter 254, Election Code,
- 18 that is required to be filed on or after the effective date of this
- 19 Act. A report under Chapter 254, Election Code, that is required to
- 20 be filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- law in effect on the date the report is required to be filed, and the
- 22 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
