- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 6.001, Family Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 6.001. INSUPPORTABILITY. On the petition of either
- 8 <u>spouse of</u> [party to] a marriage, the court may grant a divorce
- 9 without regard to fault if the marriage has become insupportable
- 10 because of discord or conflict of personalities that destroys the
- 11 legitimate ends of the marital relationship and prevents any
- 12 reasonable expectation of reconciliation.
- SECTION 2. Section 7.001, Family Code, is amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 Sec. 7.001. GENERAL RULE OF PROPERTY DIVISION. In a decree
- of divorce or annulment, the court shall order a division of the
- 17 estate of the spouses [parties] in a manner that the court deems
- 18 just and right, having due regard for the rights of each spouse
- 19 [party] and any children of the marriage. The court shall consider
- 20 any fault of the spouses in dividing the estate of the spouses.
- 21 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 22 decree of divorce rendered in a suit for dissolution of a marriage
- 23 that is pending on the effective date of this Act or filed on or
- 24 after that date.
