A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the presentation of Star of Texas awards to peace
- 3 officers, firefighters, and emergency medical first responders who
- 4 are killed or sustain serious or fatal injuries in the line of duty.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 3105.002(a), Government Code, as added
- 7 by Chapter 614, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 8 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) The Peace Officers' Star of Texas Award shall [may] be
- 10 awarded to each [a] peace officer who is seriously injured in the
- line of duty and $[\frac{\partial \mathbf{r}}{\partial t}]$ the surviving next of kin of each $[\frac{\partial \mathbf{r}}{\partial t}]$ peace
- 12 officer who is killed or sustains a fatal injury in the line of
- 13 duty.
- SECTION 2. Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, as added
- 15 by Chapter 614, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 16 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) The Firefighters' Star of Texas Award <u>shall</u> [may] be
- awarded to \underline{each} [\underline{a}] firefighter who is seriously injured in the line
- of duty \underline{and} [\underline{er}] the surviving next of kin of \underline{each} [\underline{a}] firefighter
- 20 who is killed or sustains a fatal injury in the line of duty.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 3105.004(a), Government Code, as added
- 22 by Chapter 614, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 23 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) The Emergency Medical First Responders' Star of Texas

- 1 Award <u>shall</u> [may] be awarded to <u>each</u> [an] emergency medical first
- 2 responder who is seriously injured in the line of duty and [or] the
- 3 surviving next of kin of each [an] emergency medical first
- 4 responder who is killed or sustains a fatal injury in the line of
- 5 duty.
- 6 SECTION 4. (a) The Peace Officers' Star of Texas Award
- 7 awarded under Section 3105.002(a), Government Code, as amended by
- 8 this Act, shall be awarded to peace officers who are seriously
- 9 injured, or the surviving next of kin of officers who are killed or
- 10 sustain a fatal injury, on or after September 1, 2003.
- 11 (b) The Firefighters' Star of Texas Award awarded under
- 12 Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, as amended by this Act, shall
- 13 be awarded to firefighters who are seriously injured, or the
- 14 surviving next of kin of firefighters who are killed or sustain a
- 15 fatal injury, on or after September 1, 2003.
- 16 (c) The Emergency Medical First Responders' Star of Texas
- 17 Award awarded under Section 3105.004(a), Government Code, as
- amended by this Act, shall be awarded to emergency medical first
- 19 responders who are seriously injured, or the surviving next of kin
- 20 of emergency medical first responders who are killed or sustain a
- 21 fatal injury, on or after September 1, 2003.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
