## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the transfer of jurisdiction over the Fleet Admiral
- 3 Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum and other historical sites
- 4 from the Parks and Wildlife Department to the Texas Historical
- 5 Commission.

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- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Sections 442.001-442.018, Government Code, are
- 8 designated as Subchapter A, Chapter 442, Government Code, and a
- 9 heading to Subchapter A is added to read as follows:

## 10 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 442, Government Code, as
- 12 added by this Act, is amended by adding Section 442.019 to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 Sec. 442.019. TRANSFER OF HISTORICAL SITES FROM PARKS AND
- 15 WILDLIFE. (a) By interagency agreement, a historical site under
- 16 the jurisdiction of the Parks and Wildlife Department may be
- 17 transferred to the commission.
- (b) If jurisdiction over a historical site is transferred
- 19 under this section, all rights, powers, duties, obligations,
- 20 functions, activities, property, and programs of the Parks and
- 21 Wildlife Department relating to the historical site are transferred
- 22 <u>to the commission</u>.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter Q, Chapter 22, Parks and Wildlife
- 24 Code, is redesignated as Subchapter B, Chapter 442, Government

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- 1 Code, and amended to read as follows:
- SUBCHAPTER B  $[\frac{Q}{2}]$ . FLEET ADMIRAL CHESTER W. NIMITZ MEMORIAL NAVAL
- 3 MUSEUM
- 4 Sec. 442.051 [22.231]. MUSEUM JURISDICTION. The Fleet
- 5 Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum is under the
- 6 jurisdiction of the commission [department].
- 7 Sec. 442.052 [22.232]. POWERS OF COMMISSION [DEPARTMENT].
- 8 With respect to the Nimitz museum and in addition to its other
- 9 powers and duties, the commission [department]:
- 10 (1) shall foster and commemorate the memory of the era
- of supreme United States naval power upon the seas and the men and
- 12 women of the armed services whose gallant and selfless dedication
- 13 to duty made this era possible;
- 14 (2) shall administer the Fleet Admiral Chester W.
- Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum at Fredericksburg;
- 16 (3) shall act in any other capacity relative to
- 17 preserving naval documents, relics, and other items of historical
- 18 interest;
- 19 (4) may employ and discharge a museum director and
- 20 other employees it deems necessary to fulfill its duties and
- 21 responsibilities within the limits of funds available;
- 22 (5) may accept on behalf of the State of Texas
- 23 donations of money, property, and historical relics related to the
- 24 museum's theme; and
- 25 (6) may acquire property and historical relics by
- 26 purchase within the limits of funds available.
- Sec. 442.053 [22.233]. REVENUE BONDS FOR MUSEUM. (a) The

- 1  $\underline{\text{commission}}$  [ $\underline{\text{department}_r}$ ] by resolution [ $\underline{\text{of the commission}_r}$ ] may
- 2 request the Texas Public Finance Authority to issue revenue bonds
- 3 or other revenue obligations to finance the repair, renovation,
- 4 improvement, expansion, and equipping of the Nimitz museum for one
- or more projects not to exceed an aggregated estimated cost of \$9
- 6 million.
- 7 (b) On receipt of a request by the <a href="commission">commission</a> [department]
- 8 under this section, the Texas Public Finance Authority shall
- 9 promptly issue the bonds or other revenue obligations under and in
- 10 accordance with Chapter 1232[ Government Code].
- 11 (c) The commission [department] shall deposit the proceeds
- 12 of revenue bonds or other revenue obligations issued under this
- 13 section to the credit of the Nimitz museum account [Texas parks and
- 14 wildlife conservation and capital account and may use the proceeds
- only to finance the repair, renovation, improvement, expansion, and
- 16 equipping of the museum.
- 17 (d) The commission [Notwithstanding any other law, the
- 18 department] may contract with the Admiral Nimitz Foundation for the
- 19 renovation, improvement, or expansion of the museum.
- 20 (e) The commission [department] may accept contributions
- 21 from the Admiral Nimitz Foundation and other sources in connection
- 22 with the repair, renovation, improvement, expansion, equipping, or
- 23 operation of the museum.
- Sec. 442.054. NIMITZ MUSEUM ACCOUNT. (a) The Nimitz museum
- 25 account is a separate account in the general revenue fund.
- 26 (b) The account consists of:
- 27 (1) transfers made to the account;

- 1 (2) revenue from the operation of the Fleet Admiral
- 2 Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum;
- 3 (3) grants and donations made by the Admiral Nimitz
- 4 Foundation and other sources; and
- 5 (4) income earned on investments of money in the
- 6 account.
- 7 (c) Appropriations to the commission for the preservation,
- 8 operation, or maintenance of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz
- 9 Memorial Naval Museum shall be deposited to the credit of the
- 10 <u>account.</u>
- 11 (d) The commission may use money in the account to
- 12 administer this subchapter, including to support the preservation,
- 13 repair, renovation, improvement, expansion, equipping, operation,
- or maintenance of the museum or acquisition of historical items
- appropriate to the museum.
- (e) Any money in the account not used in a fiscal year
- 17 remains in the account. The account is exempt from the application
- of <u>Section 403.095</u>, <u>Government Code</u>.
- 19 Sec. 442.055. GRANTS; DONATIONS. The commission may accept
- 20 a grant or donation for any program or purpose of the Fleet Admiral
- 21 Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum.
- 22 SECTION 4. (a) On November 1, 2005, the following are
- 23 transferred to the Texas Historical Commission:
- 24 (1) all powers, duties, obligations, and liabilities
- of the Parks and Wildlife Department relating to the Fleet Admiral
- 26 Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum;
- 27 (2) all unobligated and unexpended funds appropriated

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- 1 to the Parks and Wildlife Department designated for the
- 2 administration of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial
- 3 Naval Museum;
- 4 (3) all equipment and property of the Parks and
- 5 Wildlife Department used for the administration of or related to
- 6 the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum; and
- 7 (4) all files and other records of the Parks and
- 8 Wildlife Department kept by the department regarding the Fleet
- 9 Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum.
- 10 (b) A rule adopted by the Parks and Wildlife Department that
- is in effect immediately before November 1, 2005, and that relates
- 12 to the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum is, on
- 13 November 1, 2005, a rule of the Texas Historical Commission and
- 14 remains in effect until amended or repealed by the Texas Historical
- 15 Commission.
- 16 (c) Any money in the Texas parks and wildlife conservation
- 17 and capital account deposited to the credit of the Fleet Admiral
- 18 Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum on October 31, 2005, is
- 19 transferred on November 1, 2005, to the Nimitz museum account.
- 20 (d) The transfers under this Act do not diminish or impair
- 21 the rights of a holder of an outstanding bond or other obligation
- 22 issued by the Parks and Wildlife Department under former Section
- 23 22.233, Parks and Wildlife Code.
- (e) Before November 1, 2005, the Parks and Wildlife
- 25 Department may agree with the Texas Historical Commission to
- 26 transfer any property of the Parks and Wildlife Department to the
- 27 Texas Historical Commission to implement the transfer required by

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- 1 this Act.
- 2 (f) In the period beginning on the effective date of this
- 3 Act and ending on November 1, 2005, the Parks and Wildlife
- 4 Department shall continue to perform functions and activities under
- 5 Subchapter Q, Chapter 22, Parks and Wildlife Code, as if that
- 6 subchapter had not been amended by this Act, and the former law is
- 7 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
