12	(1) "Firearm" has the meaning assigned by Section

14	(2) "Navigable river or stream" has the meaning
15	assigned by Section 90.001.
16	(b) This section applies only to a navigable river or stream
17	located wholly or partly in Dimmit, Edwards, Frio, Kenedy, Kerr,
18	<u>Kimble, Llano, Mason, Maverick, Real, Uvalde, or Zavala County.</u>
19	(c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a person may not
20	discharge a firearm or shoot an arrow from any kind of bow if:
21	(1) the person is located in or on the bed or bank of a
22	navigable river or stream at the time the firearm is discharged or
23	the arrow is shot from the bow; or
24	(2) any portion of the ammunition discharged or arrow

3	(d) This section does not apply to:
4	(1) an individual acting in the scope of the
5	individual's duties as a peace officer or department employee; or
6	(2) the discharge of a shotgun loaded with ammunition
7	that releases only shot when discharged.
8	(e) This section does not limit the ability of a license
9	holder to carry a concealed handgun under the authority of
10	Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code.
11	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
