16	(b) This section applies only to a navigable river or stream	
17	located wholly or partly in Dimmit, Edwards, Frio, Kenedy, Llano,	
18	Maverick, Real, Uvalde, or Zavala County.	
19	(c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a person may not	
20	discharge a firearm or shoot an arrow from any kind of bow if:	
21	(1) the person is located in or on the bed or bank of a	
22	navigable river or stream at the time the firearm is discharged or	
23	the arrow is shot from the bow; or	
24	(2) any portion of the ammunition discharged or arrow	

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- 1 shot could physically contact the bed or bank of a navigable river

- 3 <u>(d)</u> This section does not apply to:
- 4 (1) an individual acting in the scope of the
- 5 <u>individual's duties as a peace officer or department employee; or</u>
- 6 (2) the discharge of a shotgun loaded with ammunition

- 8 <u>(e) This section does not limit the ability of a license</u>
- 9 holder to carry a concealed handgun under the authority of
- 10 Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
