- 16 (b) This section applies only to a navigable river or stream
- 17 located wholly or partly in Dimmit, Edwards, Frio, Kenedy, Kerr,
- 18 Kimble, Llano, Mason, Maverick, Real, Uvalde, or Zavala County.
- (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a person may not
- 20 discharge a firearm or shoot an arrow from any kind of bow if:
- 21 (1) the person is located in or on the bed or bank of a

- 7 that releases only shot when discharged.
- 8 <u>(e) This section does not limit the ability of a license</u>
- 9 holder to carry a concealed handgun under the authority of
- 10 Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code.
