## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the expansion of the operation game thief program to 3 include certain other violations of law. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 12.201, Parks and Wildlife Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 12.201. CREATION OF FUND. The department may accept 7 and deposit in a special fund outside the state treasury, called the 8 operation game thief fund, donations from any person made for 9 purposes of this subchapter. Funds deposited in the operation game 10 11 thief fund may be used only for the maintenance of that fund, 12 promotion of the operation game thief program through advertisement 13 and marketing, the development, acquisition, and implementation of 14 technological advancements to facilitate the apprehension and prosecution of persons who violate laws of this state intended to 15 protect the state's natural or cultural resources or the public 16 safety of persons using those natural or cultural resources, and 17 18 payment of rewards and death benefits authorized by this subchapter. The Operation Game Thief Committee shall adopt rules 19 for the implementation of the operation game thief program and 20 21 maintenance of the operation game thief fund. 22 SECTION 2. Section 12.203(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is

- 6 (1) Subchapter B, Chapter 365, Health and Safety Code; 7 (2) Subchapter E, Chapter 191, Natural Resources Code; 8 (3) Chapter 28 or Section 30.05, 31.03, 31.11, 37.10, 49.06, 49.07, or 49.08, Penal Code; 9

  - (4) Chapter 160, Tax Code; or

(5) Subchapter E, Chapter 7, or Subchapter D, Chapter 11 26, Water Code [that applies to the taking, possession, or sale of 12 an animal, bird, reptile, or fish may apply to the committee for a 13 14 reward to be paid from the operation game thief fund].

15 SECTION 3. Section 12.203(d), Parks and Wildlife Code, is repealed. 16

17 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section, the conviction of a person, before the effective date of 18 this Act, for a violation of a law included under Section 12.203(a), 19 Parks and Wildlife Code, as amended by this Act, may not be the 20 basis of a claim for reward made under Subchapter C, Chapter 12, 21 Parks and Wildlife Code, as amended by this Act. 22

The conviction of a person before the effective date of 23 (b) 24 this Act for a flagrant violation of the Parks and Wildlife Code or a regulation or proclamation adopted under that code applicable to 25 26 the taking, possession, or sale of an animal, bird, reptile, or fish may be the basis of a claim for reward made under Subchapter C, 27
