H.B. No. 2035

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to appointments to the Tobacco Settlement Permanent Trust
3 Account Investment Advisory Committee.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 403.1042(b), Government Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 (b) The advisory committee is composed of 11 members
8 appointed as follows:

9 (1) one member appointed by the comptroller to
10 represent a public hospital or hospital district located in a
11 county with a population of 50,000 or less or a public hospital
12 owned or maintained by a municipality;

13 (2) one member appointed by the political subdivision
14 that, in the year preceding the appointment, received the largest
15 annual distribution paid from the account;

16 (3) one member appointed by the political subdivision
17 that, in the year preceding the appointment, received the second
18 largest annual distribution paid from the account;

19 (4) four members appointed by the Texas Conference of
20 Urban Counties, which shall receive nominations from political
21 subdivisions that, ~~and~~

22 [~~(A)~~] in the year preceding the appointment,
23 received the 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th
24 largest annual distribution paid from the account [~~and~~

1 ~~[(B) do not have an appointee serving on the~~
2 ~~advisory committee at the time of appointment];~~

3 (5) one member appointed by the County Judges and
4 Commissioners Association of Texas;

5 (6) one member appointed by the North and East Texas
6 County Judges and Commissioners Association;

7 (7) one member appointed by the South Texas County
8 Judges and Commissioners Association; and

9 (8) one member appointed by the West Texas County
10 Judges and Commissioners Association.

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
