A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 Relating to a Pilot Project to provide additional capacity for
- 3 higher education undergraduate education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter M, Chapter 56, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 56.3076 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 56.3076. Pilot Project to address existing capacity
- 8 for higher education undergraduate education.
- 9 (a) To the extent existing facilities, administrative
- 10 <u>infrastructure</u> and faculty can provide broad baccalaureate program
- options for the growing higher education undergraduate enrollment,
- 12 and in order to mitigate the need for additional construction and
- 13 the hiring of additional faculty, The Texas Higher Education
- 14 Coordinating Board shall award grants in keeping with this
- 15 Subchapter in an amount equal to the grant award under Section
- 16 56.307 to a student who
- 17 (1) enrolls in either of the pilot project
- 18 <u>institutions established by this section who fulfills the</u>
- 19 eligibility requirements of Section 56.304 and
- 20 (2) meets all the requirements to receive a grant
- 21 award under Section 56.307.
- 22 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 23 award initial awards under this Subchapter to up to 1,000 students
- 24 at Angelo State University and 600 students at Sul Ross State

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- 1 University for the 2005-06 and 2006-07 academic years and shall
- 2 award continuation grants to pilot project students in future years
- 3 in accordance with Section 56.305.
- 4 (c) Students eligible for Texas Grants under the Pilot
- 5 Project provisions of Section 56.0876 are also eligible to apply
- 6 for and receive other financial aid that they may be qualified to
- 7 receive at Angelo State University or Sul Ross State University.
- 8 The sum of all financial aid may not exceed the student's financial
- 9 need.
- 10 (d) Funding for awards to pilot project students shall be
- 11 provided through Texas Grants and B-on-Time funding.
- 12 (e) The Higher Education Coordinating Board shall develop
- 13 the criteria for evaluating the pilot project and will report on
- 14 their findings to the 80th Legislature in the spring of 2007. The
- 15 pilot project will be evaluated by the legislature and a
- determination will be made by the 80th legislature concerning the
- 17 continuation and expansion of the program to include other
- 18 universities with existing capacity.
- 19 SECTION 2. (a) Section 1 of this Act applies beginning with
- 20 the 2005-2006 academic year.
- 21 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 22 adopt rules for the administration of Subchapter M, Chapter 56,
- 23 Education Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after
- 24 this Act takes effect, but no later than June 1, 2005. For that
- 25 purpose, The Coordinating Board may adopt the initial rules in the
- 26 manner provided by law for emergency rules.
- 27 SECTION 3. This act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the votes necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
