A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to education programs for gifted and talented students.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 29.123, Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 29.123. STATE PLAN; ASSISTANCE. (a) The State Board
- 7 of Education shall develop and periodically update a state plan for
- 8 the education of gifted and talented students to guide school
- 9 districts in establishing and improving programs for identified
- 10 students.
- 11 (b) The regional education service centers may assist
- 12 districts in implementing the state plan. In addition to obtaining
- 13 assistance from a regional education service center, a district may
- 14 obtain other assistance in implementing the plan.
- 15 (c) The plan shall be used for accountability purposes to
- 16 measure the performance of districts in providing services to
- 17 students identified as gifted and talented. The plan's
- 18 <u>accountability measures must be performance-based.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Sections 29.1231, 29.124, 29.125, and 29.126 to
- 21 read as follows:
- Sec. 29.1231. STATE PLAN DURING 2006-2007 SCHOOL YEAR FOR
- 23 CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS. (a) During the 2006-2007 school year, a
- 24 school district may participate in either the state plan developed

- 1 by the State Board of Education for the 2005-2006 school year or the
- 2 performance-based state plan developed by the board for the
- 3 2006-2007 school year.
- 4 (b) A school district that participates in the state plan
- 5 developed for the 2005-2006 school year must fully comply with that
- 6 state plan, but is not subject to the requirements of Section 29.124
- 7 <u>or 29.125.</u>
- 8 (c) A school district that participates in the state plan
- 9 developed for the 2005-2006 school year is entitled to funding for
- 10 not more than five percent of the district's students in average
- 11 daily attendance who are eligible for funding under Section 42.156.
- 12 (d) Beginning with the 2007-2008 school year, each school
- district shall participate in and comply with the performance-based
- 14 state plan.
- (e) This section expires September 1, 2007.
- Sec. 29.124. MINIMUM LEVEL OF PERFORMANCE UNDER STATE PLAN.
- 17 (a) The agency shall set a minimum level of performance that a
- 18 school district is required to achieve in order to be in compliance
- 19 with the state plan. The agency may periodically raise the level of
- 20 performance so that a district is required to demonstrate that an
- 21 increasing number of gifted and talented students in the district
- 22 are meeting increasingly higher performance levels.
- 23 (b) A school district that achieves the minimum level of
- 24 performance is entitled to funding for each district student in
- 25 average daily attendance who is eligible for funding under Section
- 26 42.156.
- 27 (c) A school district that does not achieve the minimum

- 1 level of performance for two consecutive school years must develop
- 2 and implement a plan of action for achieving the minimum level of
- 3 performance the following school year. A district that does not
- 4 achieve the minimum level of performance the following school year
- 5 is subject to sanctions as determined by the agency. The sanctions
- 6 may include a loss of funding for the district's gifted and talented
- 7 program.
- 8 Sec. 29.125. DOCUMENTATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH STATE PLAN.
- 9 (a) To receive funding under Section 42.156, each school year a
- 10 school district shall provide the agency with information that:
- 11 (1) demonstrates that the district has achieved the
- 12 minimum level of performance set by the agency under Section
- 13 29.124;
- 14 (2) documents any changes in the total number of
- full-time equivalent gifted and talented personnel in the district;
- 16 and
- 17 (3) documents any reduction in district resources
- 18 dedicated to gifted and talented programs in the district.
- 19 (b) After evaluating the information submitted by a school
- 20 district under Subsection (a), the agency may request additional
- 21 <u>information from the district to verify that the district has</u>
- 22 <u>achieved the minimum level of performance set by the agency under</u>
- 23 Section 29.124.
- Sec. 29.126. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. The campus report
- 25 <u>card under Section 39.052</u>, the performance report under Section
- 26 39.053, and the comprehensive annual report under Section 39.182
- 27 must include information on the race, ethnicity, gender,

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- 1 socioeconomic status, and limited English proficiency status of
- 2 gifted and talented students at the campus, in the district, or in
- 3 the state, as applicable. The reports must also analyze the
- 4 percentage of gifted and talented students who were formerly
- 5 identified as students of limited English proficiency and who have
- 6 since exited from a bilingual education or special language
- 7 program.
- 8 SECTION 3. Section 42.156(c), Education Code, is repealed.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2006-2007
- 10 school year.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
