## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorizing a special events trust fund to support
- 3 certain Olympic events, including training and development
- 4 activities.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 5A(a)(1), (4), and (5), Chapter 1507,
- 7 Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article
- 8 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) "Endorsing county" means a county that has a
- 11 population of 250,000 [one million] or more and that contains a site
- 12 selected by a site selection organization for one or more games.
- 13 (4) "Game" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate
- 14 Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National
- 15 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the National Hockey League
- 16 All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star Game, a National
- 17 Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl Championship Series game, a
- 18 World Cup Soccer game, [or] the World Games, a national collegiate
- 19 championship of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national
- 20 governing body of the sport that is recognized by the United States
- 21 Olympic Committee, an Olympic activity, including a Junior or
- 22 <u>Senior activity, training program, or feeder program sanctioned by</u>
- 23 the United States Olympic Committee's Community Olympic
- 24 Development Program. The term includes any events and activities

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- 1 related to or associated with the games.
- 2 (5) "Site selection organization" means the National
- 3 Football League, the National Collegiate Athletic Association, the
- 4 National Basketball Association, the National Hockey League, Major
- 5 League Baseball, the Federation Internationale de Football
- 6 Association (FIFA), [or] the International World Games
- 7 Association, the United States Olympic Committee, or the national
- 8 governing body of a sport that is recognized as such by the United
- 9 States Olympic Committee.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
